### Cleaning Your Roller Shades

With a little preventive care, roller shades can beautify your windows for years without needing to be replaced. A few cleaning strategies will ensure your blinds remain in top shape with little effort on your part.

The classic roller shade comes in a wide range of fabrics which, generally speaking, are kept looking their best with a gentle onceover with your vacuum's soft brush tool, and a little spot cleaning with a damp cloth where needed. Sometimes, however, in cases where dust and dirt have been allowed to accumulate over a long period of time, a more thorough cleaning may be required. For products not supplied by Brite Blinds, please consult the manufacturer's directions for cleaning their products.

#### **Cleaning Supplies**

A dusting tool is essential for maintenance and light cleaning. Opt for microfiber dusters or cloths as they will attract dust rather than scatter it all over. A vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment will capture dust effectively. For more in-depth cleaning, use a sponge or soft dust cloth and a mild detergent mixed with warm water. Non-abrasive household cleaners can be substituted, but avoid any products that contain bleach, CFC's or petroleum. Folex is a gentle, non-toxic and odor-free option that can also be used on carpets, walls and upholstery. Another alternative is to make your own cleanser. Fill a spray pump bottle with a mixture of 2 cups of warm water, 1/2 tsp. dish detergent, and 1/4 cup white distilled vinegar. Add some lemon juice for a clean, fresh scent.

#### Maintenance

Dusting is a valuable preventive measure that will save you time and effort in the long run by removing debris that can build up over time and make cleaning a chore. A dusting tool is essential for maintenance and light cleaning. Opt for microfiber dusters or cloths as they will attract dust rather than scatter it all over. A vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment will capture dust effectively.

### Spot Cleaning

For small spots, use a sponge or soft dust cloth and a mild detergent mixed with warm water. Non-abrasive household cleaners can be substituted, but avoid any products that contain bleach, CFC's or petroleum. Folex is a gentle, nontoxic and odor-free option that can also be used on carpets, walls and upholstery. Another alternative is to make your own cleanser. Fill a spray pump bottle with a mixture of 2 cups of warm water, 1/2 tsp. dish detergent, and 1/4 cup white distilled vinegar. Add some lemon juice for a clean, fresh scent. Dry with a soft, clean cloth.

### Deep Cleaning Your Brite Blinds

Supplies:

- Mild laundry detergent
- Bleach (optional)
- Sponge or soft cloths

- Old toothbrush
- Vacuum with brush attachment
- Drying rack or outside clothesline
- Bath tub
- Warm water
- Friend to help (optional)

- 1. If the blinds are especially dirty, begin by vacuuming away surface dirt on exposed blinds using a brush attachment.
- 2. Remove the blinds from the roller and carefully lay them flat on the floor.
- 3. Use the brush attachment on the vacuum to gently brush the entire surface and remove loose dirt, dead bugs, spiderwebs, etc.
- 4. Half fill a bathtub with warm water.
- Add some laundry detergent to the water and mix together until a few suds begin to form on the surface. If the blinds are white, a small amount of bleach can be added to the water as well.



- 6. Next, carefully lay the blinds in the tub. If the blinds are long, it is okay to loosely layer them in an accordion fashion.
- 7. Allow them to soak in the soapy water for 2 hours.
- 8. Next, start at one end of the blinds and gently wipe back and forth with a soft cloth or sponge. This will help remove any remaining dirt and/or stains.
- 9. For tough stains, scrub them gently with an old toothbrush.
- 10. Drain the sudsy water from the tub.
- 11. Fill with clean water and rinse the blinds. Repeat until all of the soap is removed. If soap residue remains on the blinds, it will act as a magnet quickly collecting dirt and dust.
- 12. If a partner is available to assist, the blinds can be held up and rinsed with a shower sprayer for quicker soap removal.
- 13. Lay the blinds over a drying rack or outside on a clothesline until they are completely dried.
- 14. Attach them back onto the roller and reinstall them over the window.

### Additional Tips & Ideas

- Color-safe bleach can be used for added cleaning power on colored blinds.
- Avoid using harsh cleaners on the fabric as it may damage the material.
- Regular cleanings will help keep major dirt and stains from building up on roller blinds.
